Annual Parent Notice of Right to Request Teacher and Paraprofessional Qualifications

Dear Parent or Guardian:

Our school receives federal funds for Title I programs that are part of the *No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Act of 2001*.

Under *NCLB*, you have the right to request information regarding the professional qualifications of your child's classroom teacher(s), and qualifications of instructional aides or paraprofessionals.

You have the right to know:

- a. Whether or not the teacher has met West Virginia's licensure and certification requirements for the grade levels and subject areas in which instruction is required by the teacher;
- b. Whether the teacher is teaching under an emergency or other provisional status through which state licensing requirements have been waived;
- c. The college major and any other graduate certification or degree held by the teacher, and the field of discipline of the certification or degree; and,
- d. Whether your child is provided services by aides/paraprofessional, and if so, their qualifications.
